



Raincoat

- needs to cover hips
- have a hood
- be water proof

Please note a puffer jacket is not a suitable alternative. Students need a raincoat.



Three bags needed for camp are:

Day pack – (school bag is a good size for this)
Will carry raincoat, lunch, warm top, water bottle, sunscreen etc when out and about.

Gear bag

Holds all spare clothes, towels, toiletries etc.

Tramping pack for walk up to Powell Hut.

- with waist band
- ideally 50 litres capacity
- will need to fit sleeping bag (try to get one that compresses down), rain coat, thermals, change of clothes, lunch and other food plus other small items like beanie, tooth brush, torch etc.

It is important that the pack fits the student correctly as it is difficult to walk with an oversized pack. Please note that we do have some suitable packs at school students can borrow if needed.



Shoes for Tramp

Students can tramp up to Powell Hut in a good pair of trainers (as used for P.E. lessons at school). The shoes need to be supportive and have a decent sole for grip.

Only bring tramping boots if they are comfortable. It is a long walk and we want to avoid blisters. It is not a good idea to borrow tramping boots or go out and buy them just before the tramp.

Please note canvas sneakers are not a suitable option for this walk.
